## **2) Cambridgeshire Future Transport**

This expansion was a County Council decision when setting the Budget in March with officers asked to set up a group with a membership that broadly reflected the balance of the Council to consider Community transport and in particular, the additional budget allocation of £500, 000 that Full Council agreed should be added to the Business Plan budget to spend on community transport. It will make recommendations to E&E Committee about the expenditure.
