

Introduction to Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Clinical Commissioning Group- Commissioning for Quality CUHFT Quality Concerns presentation.

Purpose: This presentation to the Health Committee is in response to the questions raised by the committee in relation to the Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection of Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (CUHFT) in April and May 2015.

The CQC carried out an announced inspection at CUHFT on 21-24 April and 7 May 2015. This was part of the regular inspection programme. The final report was presented at the Quality Summit in September 2015. The outcomes of this inspection are detailed below:

- CUHFT achieved an overall rating of Inadequate
- The CQC domain for Caring was rated as Outstanding
- Effectiveness was rated as Required Improvement
- Safe, Responsive and Well-Led was rated as Inadequate.
- Services for children and young people were rated as Good
- Maternity and Gynaecology, Outpatients, and diagnostic imaging Inadequate
- Other services were rated as Requires Improvement

CUHFT has developed an improvement plan to address the issues raised by the CQC, in collaboration with the CCG and other stakeholders. This will be monitored through oversight arrangements established by Monitor.
