Dispensation, Under S.33 Localism Act 2011, in Respect of the Debate at Full

Due to the wide ranging potential financial and other impact of the council's proposed

business plan it raises the potential that significant numbers of the elected members

will be excluded from the debate in accordance with the members' code of conduct.

In the circumstances the Monitoring officer has concluded that the interests of the

residents of Cambridgeshire are best served by ensuring that their elected

representatives are able to represent them within this debate.

Accordingly, pursuant to S.33(2)(c) of the Localism Act 2012, the monitoring officer

has exercised his discretion to grant a dispensation to all elected members of

Cambridgeshire County taking part in the debate on the council's business plan

during the meeting of Full Council on the 14th February 2017.

This dispensation applies to all restrictions, under the members' code of conduct, on

elected members' participation in the debate.
