## ADDENDUM TO AGENDA ITEM 3 – SCHOOLS BUDGET UPDATE

## **DE-DELEGATIONS FROM MAINTAINED PRIMARY SCHOOL BUDGETS**

- 1.1. De-delegations are compulsory levies applied to maintained primary schools after the schools' budget shares have been calculated, and must be agreed by representatives of those heads on Schools Forum.
- 1.2. As approved at the Schools Forum meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> December the following dedelegations will be applied for 2016-17:
- Cambridgeshire Racial Equality and Diversity Service (CREDS)– Cambridgeshire Primary Heads (CPH) agreed to revise the methodology used to calculate this de-delegation. As a result, the cost per pupil has reduced to £3 (from £12) whilst the cost per English as an additional language (EAL) pupil has increased to £160 (from £142.50).
- 1.4. School Leaders & Governors Online Information Service and Copyright Subscriptions- There is currently an ongoing tender process in respect of the School Leaders & Governors Online Information Service. It is expected that the current de-delegation of £307 per school and 50p per pupil will be adequate to cover the cost of the renewal. Note: There is not currently a de-delegation for Copyright Subscriptions as the majority of licenses are now charged directly to the DSG as part of the national arrangements.
- 1.5. **Free School Meals (FSM) Eligibility –** This de-delegation will remain at the same level of £4.65 per FSM eligible pupil.
- 1.6. **Insurance –** The basis for the de-delegation has been approved, but the final per pupil amount is to be confirmed upon receipt of information from the Council's insurance team.
- 1.7. **Maternity Scheme –** It is currently forecast that the 2015/16 maternity scheme will be within budget, and therefore the de-delegation for 2016/17 will remain at £5.90 per pupil.
- 1.8. **Schools in Financial Difficulty –** There will be no change to the de-delegation of £2.10 per pupil.

- 1.9. As discussed at the previous meeting the Trade Union Facilities Time de-delegation required further work prior to a final proposal for 2016/17.
- 1.10. Trade Union Facilities Time Following discussions with Trade Union representatives, it is proposed that this de-delegation will remain at £1.10 per pupil. It has been agreed that the main County Council contribution to the Trade Union Facilities budget will be removed with the County Council instead making a small contribution to cover centrally employed teachers. Based on Academy buy-in continuing at a high level and current draw on the budget, it is expected that the current de-delegation level will remain sufficient to cover costs.
- 1.11. Therefore the final proposed 2016/17 de-delegations are:

Please note: No adjustment has been made in the figures above for mid-year Academy conversions and therefore the final available budget for these services is likely to be lower.
