These services have been retained by CCS due to the joint funded nature and the links to the CCG's Older People's Procurement Exercise which included the NHS funding contribution for those services.

Cabinet Member for Highways and Community Infrastructure / ExD: ETE Proposed changes to the City of Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012 that governs the management of the Park and Ride sites and the parking charging regime were as published on 24 January 2014. The deadline for comments was 14 February 2014.

Cabinet considered the many comments/objections raised to the proposed changes at their meeting on 4 March 2014. Cabinet agreed to an amendment to the proposed charges that would mean the £1 charge would allow a car to park for between 1 hour and 18 hours (rather than the 12 hours originally proposed) at the sites. This change was made to encourage visitors and workers to stay on in Cambridge for longer and this in turn would help boost the local night-time economy. The 18 hours would also better accommodate employees who work long shift patterns.

A contract has been let for the supply and installation of the equipment including ticket machines to enable the parking charge to be introduced in May 2014.
