Details of decision taken	Having reviewed details of the proposed Speed Limit Order and taking into account the consultation process and written representations received, the Local Member and Traffic Manager decided that the proposed scheme should be implemented as published.
	It was further decided that Great Gransden Parish Council be encouraged to submit a further LHI application for a speed limit on the additional length of Meadow Road, as requested by residents. This should include a traffic speed survey, which will indicate what speed limit might be suitable for that length of road. Cambridgeshire Police's view will also be taken into account when determining the appropriate level of speed limit.

Reasons for taking decision	The report was presented to the meeting to allow officers to explain the proposals. It was noted that:-
	 The proposed 40mph speed limit is consistent with national speed limit guidance and the principle of using a short buffer limit to reduce the speed of traffic entering/leaving the village.
	 Great Gransden Parish Council supports the residents who are seeking to extend the 40mph speed limit, but will nevertheless support the 40mph buffer limit as advertised to avoid having the funding withdrawn.
