<b>Details of decision taken</b>	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Member and the Traffic Manager determined the objections and confirmed the proposed scheme should be implemented.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
<b>Reasons for taking decision</b>	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <p>Signing would be kept to a minimum. Physical speed reducing measures are often unpopular.</p> <p>Whilst there were concerns relating to enforcement, the intention was to promote a self-contained 20mph community and the Police had not objected.</p> <p>Brampton village has an active speedwatch group who could apply for a 20mph speedwatch operation if required.</p>
