Proposal being assessed: Cambridgeshire Guided Busway - Innovative Fencing Measure

Business plan proposal number:

Key service delivery objectives and outcomes:Since February 2022 a section of the guided busway between Cambridge Railway Station and the Addenbrookes Spur junction has been partially closed and a temporary fence installed alongside it. This measure has severely impacted the busway service and connections to nearby key employment and health facilities, including Addenbrookes Hospital. The partial closure is also impacting negatively on our relationship with the bus operators due to the continuing severe damage that it is causing to their service offer.

What is the proposal: The continued partial closure is affecting both users of public transport services and the operators of these services. In partnership with bus operators and emergency services an innovative fencing solution has been developed by the Council and if implemented would allow the busway to return to full, two-way operation.

What information did you use to assess who would be affected by this proposal?: The busway and the public bus services running on it are used by all in our communities, including anyone within any of the protected characteristics group. All are in someway affected positively by his proposal.

All users of the Cambridgeshire Guided Busway between Hills Road and Long Road bridges, including pedestrians, cyclists, emergency services, bus drivers and customers of local bus operators.
