GENERAL PURPOSES COMMITTEE – TUESDAY 9TH SEPTEMBER 2014 URGENT DECISION

The Council's Constitution permits the addition of an urgent item to an agenda if it meets the urgency criteria set out in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Part 4.4(a) – Urgent Decisions.
