Details of decision taken	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Member and Head of Highways determined the objections and confirmed the proposed scheme should be implemented.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
Reasons for taking decision	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The objections received are considered not to be of such significance as to delay the implementation of the scheme.• The proposed waiting restrictions will certainly help improve visibility around the junction, thus improving the safety for those road users using the junction. Whilst parking restrictions do inevitably result in displaced parking, the length of double yellow lines advertised is relatively short and the level of displaced parking is likely to be negligible.• The informal consultation carried out by the Parish Council further demonstrates the level of support for this improvement.
