Details of decision taken	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Member and the Traffic Manager determined the objection and confirmed the proposed Disabled Persons Parking Bay should be implemented.</p> <p>The objector will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
Reasons for taking decision	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The applicant meets the County Council's eligibility criteria (apart from having access to off street parking but which the applicant has difficulty accessing). • The proposed disabled parking place will only restrict parking for approximately one car space (mostly in front of the applicant's property). If a Disabled Persons Parking Bay is no longer required it can be removed and reverted back to general use. • There is sufficient provision in the accessibility budget 2018-19.
