Details of decision taken	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Member and Head of Highways determined the objections and confirmed the proposed scheme should be implemented.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
Reasons for taking decision	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The proposed waiting restrictions are relatively short lengths that provide a suitable balance between improving safety, whilst not restricting residents and visitors ability to park in the area. • The concerns highlighted by the objectors, particularly regarding picking up/dropping off, blue badge holders and localised, essential tasks have been addressed appropriately in the report. • The proposed parking restrictions are unlikely to encourage speeding due to the relatively short lengths.
