Details of decision taken	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed traffic calming and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Members and Head of Highways determined the objections and confirmed the proposed scheme should be implemented.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
Reasons for taking decision	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Speed cushions are to be installed with minimum permissible height, with motorists being given advanced warning through appropriate signs. Road markings are to be used to identify vertical features. With street lights in the vicinity being kept illuminated to give maximum visibility to the cushions.• The locations of the speed cushions will remain the same.• Vehicular activated warning signs could be installed at a later date if specifically requested although these would have to be funded in some way.
