Traffic Regulation Order Objections Associated with the Proposal to Permit Two Way Traffic in Sedgwick Street, Cambridge and to Remove a Disabled Persons Parking Bay	It was resolved to: a) Implement the proposals in Sedgwick Street as originally published; and b) Inform the objectors accordingly.
7.	Consider Objections to Proposed RPS Amendments in Coleridge Road, Cambridge	It was resolved unanimously to: a) Introduce the proposed amendments as shown on the drawing shown in Appendix 1 as published; and b) Inform the objectors accordingly.
