Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Trading Standards Shared Services	<p>It was resolved to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) approve the proposal to merge Cambridgeshire County Council's Trading Standards service with Peterborough City Council's Trading Standards Service with effect from 1st April 2017; b) delegate the responsibility for agreeing the details of an Inter Authority Agreement with Peterborough City Council, and implementing it, to the County Council's Executive Director of Economy Transport and Environment in consultation with the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Committee.
