<b>Details of decision taken</b>	<p>Having reviewed all the details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking in to account the consultation process and comments received, the Local Member and Head of LISM determined the objections and confirmed the proposed scheme should be implemented.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
<b>Reasons for taking decision</b>	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Serious parking and access problems continue to prevail in the area, particularly given the proximity to CB1, the station and the CGB.</li><li>• There is still a major problem with Aberdeen Square, large lorries and removal vans having to reverse out of Aberdeen Avenue because there is insufficient space to manoeuvre, the proposed parking restrictions will help solve this issue.</li><li>• Access for the Emergency Services will be greatly improved through the introduction of proposed parking controls.</li></ul>
