POST MEETING ADDENDUM – AGENDA ITEM 5.

INTEGRATED TRANSPORT BLOCK FUNDING ALLOCATION PROPOSALS

The description of one of the schemes proposed for funding from the Integrated Transport Block grant Delivering Transport Strategy Aims element in the report agreed at the 10th January Economy and Environment Committee is inaccurate. The original description of the location is between Long Road and Main Street, part of the Coton to Hardwick/Comberton network. This Long Road to Main Street link is being investigated with the Greenways programme. The location covered by this scored and proposed scheme is on Main Street and Cambridge Road Hardwick, still a part of the Coton/Hardwick/Comberton network. The scheme was described in Appendix 1 Proposed schemes for Delivering Transport Strategy Aims 2019/20 and Appendix 3 Prioritised Scheme Score, and is revised as below for clarity.
