### **Questions under Agenda Item 10: Rural Travel Hubs**

#### **Question 10a: From Cllr Philippa Hart**

The Greater Cambridge Partnership published its feasibility study on Rural Travel Hubs on 4th January. While neither Meldreth nor Shepreth were selected for the initial pilot scheme, nevertheless plans were published for additional car parking adjacent to their railway stations. The lack of local consultation is well known and unacceptable, but it does not appear that any cross-referencing has taken place within GCP as both sites have planning applications for housing live or pending on them. Please can the Assembly explain how much more compulsorily purchasing these sites will be if planning permission is granted on them?

#### **Question 10b: From Cllr Janet Lockwood**

To what extent do you think travel hub parking can relieve pressure on the necklace Park and Rides?

I am thinking particularly of the expected extra traffic travelling north along the A10 through Harston.

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
