


## Cambridgeshire County Council Record of Decision

### Decision taken by an officer of the Council

<b>Title of decision</b>	Agreements for provision of energy saving and energy generation services at St Peters Academy, Huntingdon
<b>Date decision taken</b>	7 <sup>th</sup> March 2017
<b>Decision maker</b>	Chris Malyon, Chief Finance Officer
<b>Details of decision taken</b>	We are entering into two contracts, one with The Cam Academy Trust (on behalf of St Peters School), and one with Bouygues Energies and Services to provide energy savings and energy generation services under a Managed Services Agreement (MSA). The value of the MSA contract is £500,000 exactly.
<b>Reasons for taking decision</b>	As an Academy, St Peters is unable to take on additional debt for energy services. In consultation with KPMG, the Energy Team have developed an off-balance sheet solution that is acceptable to both the Academy and the Education Funding Authority.
<b>Options considered</b>	As an Academy, the option for Public Works Loan Board funds was not available.
