<b>Reasons for taking decision</b>	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals.</p> <p>It was noted that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Because of the nature of the parking restrictions to be implemented, it will be much easier for parents who need to drive past the school to drop of their children to do so.</li> <li>• The objections are valid but of insufficient weight to prevent the implementation of the Order.</li> <li>• Recommend that the Community Council conduct a review of parking within the Community with a view to enabling those who need to park their cars can easily do so</li> <li>• Further recommend that in future no new schools should be built without considering safe routes to school and that in future new schools for new communities should not be planned on the edge of said communities but should be central to them.</li> </ul>
