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1. BACKGROUND

1.1 During 2014-15, at each of its meetings, the Committee will be presented with the Public Health Finance and Performance Report detailing the financial position and the latest performance information for the Public Health Directorate for the year to that point.

- 2.1 This report provides Members with information on the budgets funded by the ring fenced Public Health grant. Of the total Public Health grant of £22.3m in 2014/15, £14.5m is managed within the Public Health Directorate, and the monitoring of this spend falls within the remit of the Health Committee. - 2.2 The remaining £7.9m of Public Health spend is managed elsewhere within the County Council, mainly within Children, Families and Adults Services, and other Committees will monitor the spend on these budgets. Appendix 2 breaks down the full Public Health grant by Committee for information.
