

# Cambridgeshire County Council Record of Decision

## Decision taken by an officer of the Council

<b>Title of decision</b>	To sign a contract committing to installing photovoltaic arrays in seven CCC-owned buildings with further energy savings measures in two of those buildings.
<b>Date decision taken</b>	18 August 2015
<b>Decision maker</b>	Chris Malyon, Chief Finance Officer
<b>Details of decision taken</b>	<p>At the General Purposes Committee meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2014, it was agreed that delegated decisions on approving funding for individual Energy Performance Contracts would be as follows:</p> <p><i>"the delegation of individual investment and contract decisions for schools, CCC buildings and sites to the Chief Finance Officer and Head of Strategic Assets in consultation with the Chairmen/woman of General Purposes, Economy and Environment and Children and Young People Committees and Executive Directors: Children, Families and Adults and Economy, Transport and Environment."</i></p>
<b>Reasons for taking decision</b>	James Wheeler, Head of Property Services, has a capital budget for energy-related building improvements and choose to use the MLEI team's procurement of Bouygues to investigate opportunities across the portfolio. This first tranche of buildings was investigated and found to have an acceptable payback of no more than 8.46 years.
<b>Options considered</b>	A larger tranche of buildings was initially considered for a wide menu of energy saving measures. These were tailored to those buildings with suitable capacity for solar photovoltaic arrays and savings measures adapted to actual on-site conditions (i.e. age of lighting, condition of controls equipment and insulation level, etc.).
