- 1.1 In March 2014 Strategic Assets undertook an option appraisal to identify potentially suitable accommodation for the Council's Archives Service. The study identified a preferred property that is located in Ely.
- 1.2 On 23rd September 2014 the Highways and Community Infrastructure Committee unanimously approved a recommendation to relocate the Archives Service to the preferred property. A copy of the Committee report is attached at Appendix A, and should be read in conjunction with this report.
