Details of decision taken	<p>Having reviewed details of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order and taking into account the consultation process and written representations received, the Local Member and Traffic Manager decided that the proposed scheme should be implemented as amended in appendix 3 of the Delegated Decision meeting report.</p> <p>The objectors will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>
Reasons for taking decision	<p>The report was presented to the meeting to allow officers to explain the proposals. It was noted that:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Traffic Regulation Order was proposed following the submission of a Local Highways Improvement Initiative (LHI) application. The LHI application requested Prohibition of Waiting at any time (Double Yellow Lines) around the splay of the junction of Ten Bell Lane and Pratt Street to improve visibility for vehicles exiting the junction. • The proposed Prohibition of Waiting at any time around the bell mouth of the junction addresses the visibility issues raised. Taking into consideration of the width of the carriageway the proposed Prohibition of Waiting at any time should not be implemented opposite the junction (Pratt Street, West side).
