	<ul> <li>The improvements at the junction for pedestrians and cyclists</li> </ul>
	outweigh the benefits to capacity (by separating the left turn into
	Cambridge Business Park from ahead traffic) as this will only be a
	minor change. As a result, the improvements are considered to be
	in accordance with policies to improve facilities for pedestrians and
	cyclists on the highway network.
	The improvements are in the context of the increased number of
	pedestrian and cycle trips using the junction as a result of the new
	office building being built nearby at plots 1 – 21 Cambridge Science
	Park. Closing the right turn into Cowley Road at its junction with
	Milton Road and Cambridge Science Park is a key part of the
	junction proposals, and allows for these improvements to be made.
	<ul> <li>The alterations to the junction/crossing suggested by Cam Cycle</li> </ul>
	are beyond the scope of the TRO however they will be passed onto
	the designer to consider. Alternatively changes to the junction could
	be considered via alternative funding streams (such as the Local
	Highways Improvement Initiative) in the future (subject to feasibility
	assessment).
