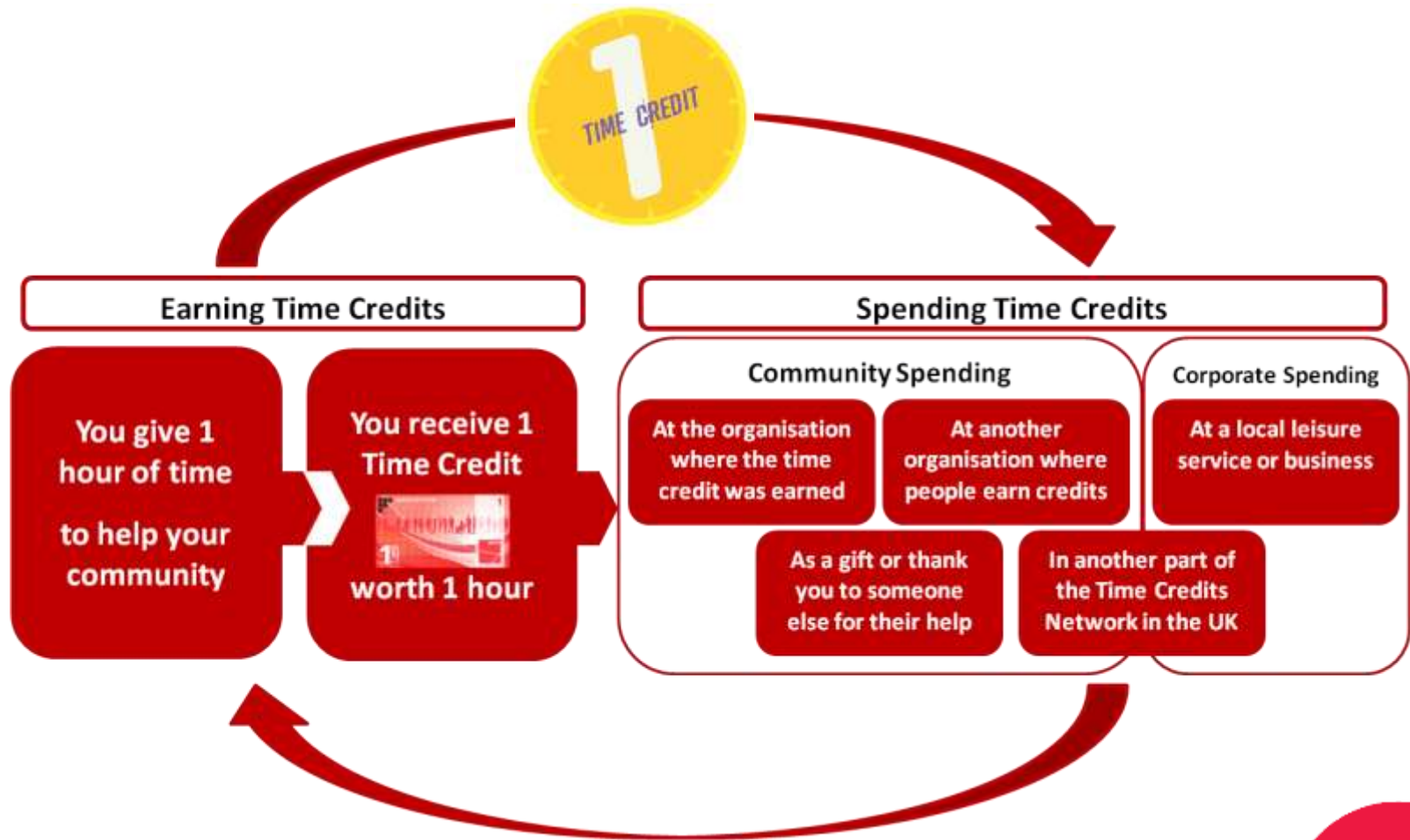

Time Credits can be earned and spend throughout the network, locally and nationally



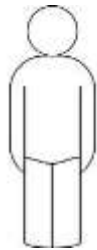

Impact of Time Credits



Nicola Parker, Head of Orchards Primary, Wisbech 'Time Credits have really taken off at Orchards, benefitting both School and families equally. Parents have taken on many roles and then used credits to pay for an after school club, or even bowling in Kings Lynn'



Pilot Project – Wisbech

- 3 Organisations; Children’s Centre, Primary School, Ferry Project
- Started August 2013
- Within 6 months – over 100 members giving 600 hours

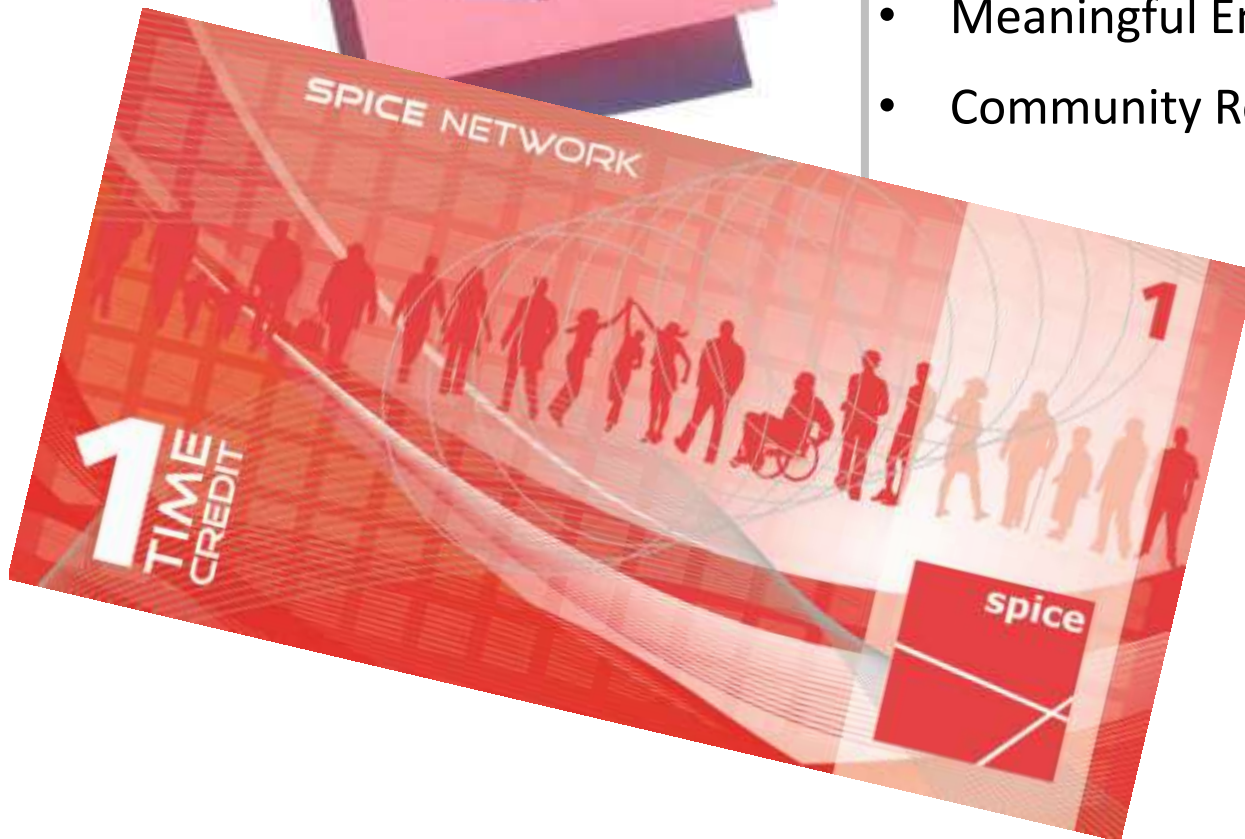
