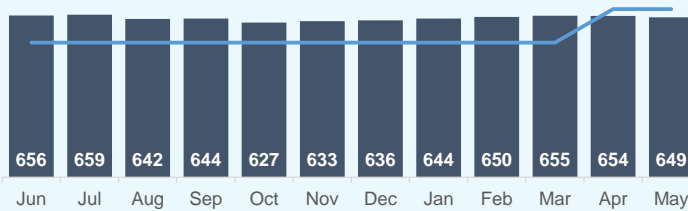

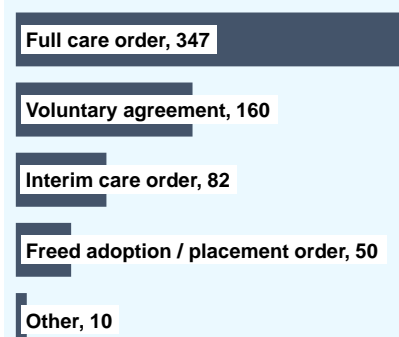

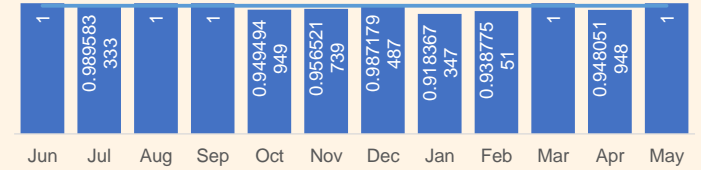

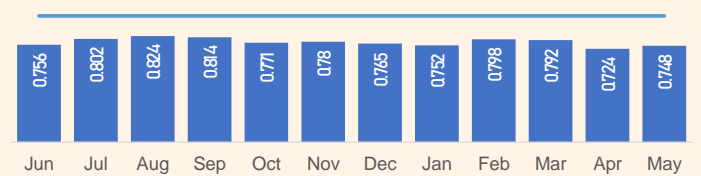

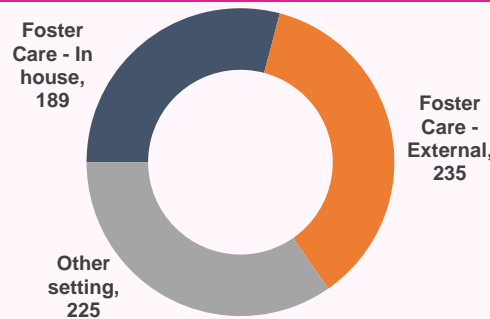

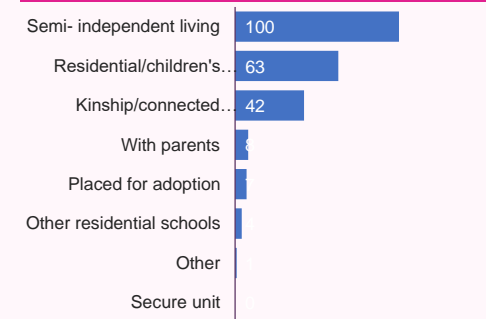

### Type of home of children in care

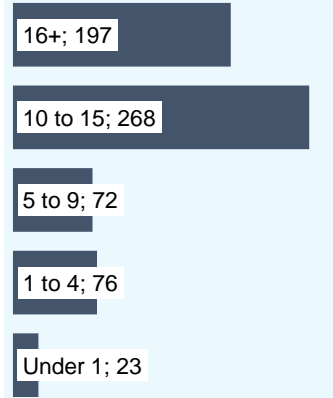

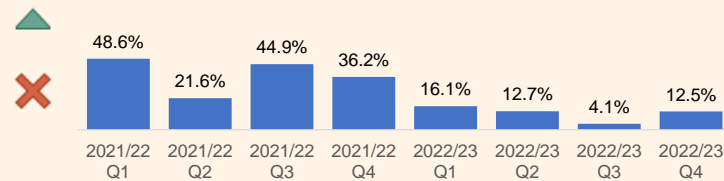

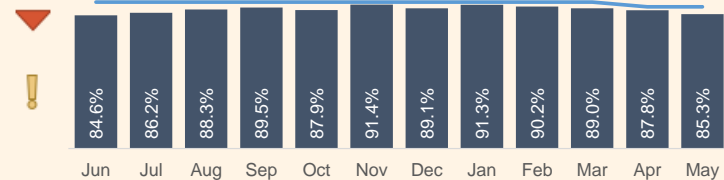

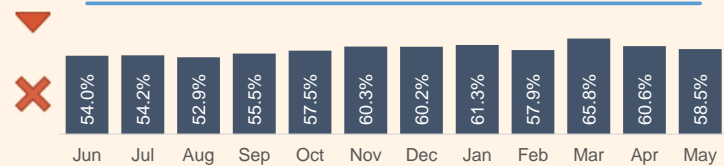

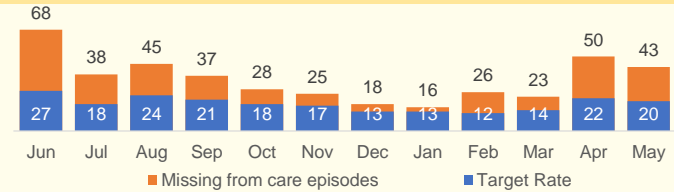
### Children in care who go missing (with number of episodes)

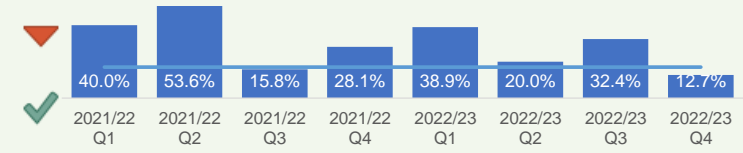

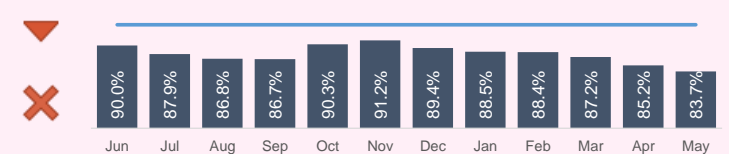

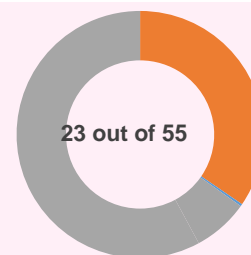
