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## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Article 16 of the Council's Constitution requires the Council's Monitoring Officer (the Local Government Shared Services Director: Legal) to keep the Constitution under review and to recommend changes to secure improvements.

### 2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 A number of changes to the Council's Constitution are proposed, which arise for the following reasons:
  - new legislative requirements
  - Cabinet decisions
- 2.2 Details of the proposed amendments are set out in Appendix 1.

## 3.0 CHIEF OFFICER PAY POLICY

- 3.1 Item No.7 on the Council agenda makes recommendations for changes to the pay policy for Chief Officers. It also proposes changes to the functions of the Appointments Committee and a change of name to reflect those changes. The Monitoring Officer recommends minor changes to the Council's constitution in line with those proposals.
- 3.2 The proposed amendments are shown in 'tracked changes' on the attached copy of the County Council's constitution (Appendix 1).
