

## Environment and Green Investment Committee Decision Statement

### 1. Notification of Chair and Vice Chair

The Committee noted that on 20 May 2025, Full Council appointed Councillor Ros Hathorn as the Chair of the Environment and Green Investment Committee and Councillor Adam Bostanci as the Vice-Chair.

### 2. Apologies for Absence and Declarations of Interest

- c) Delegate authority to the Executive Director of Place and Sustainability in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair of Environment and Green Investment Committee to review the Combined Authority's final consultation draft of the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Local Nature Recovery Strategy (LNRS) and confirm the Council's support for the document for the purposes of consultation.

### 6. Eastern Green Links 3 and 4 NSIP Proposal

It was resolved unanimously to:

- a) Delegate authority to the Executive Director of Place and Sustainability and the Service Director for Environment, Planning, and Economy to submit Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) related responses as part of the NSIP process on behalf of Cambridgeshire County Council and its regulatory functions, in consultation with the Chair and Vice Chair of the Environment and Green Investment Committee, on occasions where there is not enough time for a report to be delivered to Environment and Green Investment Committee; and
- b) Note that where delegated powers are used, draft responses will be sent to Local Members and the Members of the Environment and Green Investment Committee ahead of submission.
