



Total Referrals Received – Monthly trend includes all services October 2020 to August 2022




- The spike in number in Jul 2021 coincides with the start of YOUnited.
- An increase in referrals from September 2021 to March 2022, keeping the numbers above the mean value
- A drop in referrals seen for August 2022 which is the holiday period which is a regular variation in numbers also seen in August 2021

The number of referrals received by the ADHD service has increased since December 2021 and has stayed above the mean.



- The last 2 months have seen a downwards trend i.e. a continued decrease in referrals


Total Referrals received– Monthly trend by ASD Service October 2020 to August 2022



- NHS **Cambridgeshire and** Peterborough NHS Foundation Trust
- The number of referrals received by the ASD service has increased since Jul2021 and has stayed above the mean
- A sharp increase seen since March2022 ٠ taking the average referrals received in last 6 months to 55 (was 32 between Oct2020 to Feb2022)
- A minimum of 17 referrals in November 2020
- A maximum of 68 referrals in March 2022 and July 2022.
- A drop in referrals seen in August 2022

- The number of referrals received by this new partnership service has stayed above the mean registering an average of 648 referrals



Total Referrals received –by Gender includes all services October 2020 to August 2022




### All Mental Health Referrals October2020 - August2022: By Gender














### All Mental Health Referrals October2020 - August2022: By **Ethnic Group**







- The chart shows an increasing trend starting with a minimum value of 1837 on 07/01/2022
- Number waiting peaked on 22/07/2022 to a maximum of 2499
- A downward trend observed in the last 8 weeks
- The figure as of 16<sup>th</sup> September 2022 is 2191
- This is indicative of the measures being taken by the directorate to bring this process back in control

Total Numbers Waiting for Treatment (Waiting for Assessment + Assessment Completed)






