JOINT HEALTH AND WELLBEING STRATEGY UPDATE

1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To present the Health and Wellbeing Board (HWB) with the updated Cambridgeshire Health and Wellbeing Strategy 2012-17, for the HWB's approval.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 A paper with proposals for updating the Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy (JHWS) was presented to the HWB on 2 October 2014.
- 2.2 The approach agreed by the HWB was to:
 - Check the Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNAs) completed since 2012 (when the JHWS was published) and ensure the key findings are reflected in the JHWS
 - Map and recommend other existing joint delivery strategies in the local health and care system that could be adopted as annexes to the JHWS
- 2.3 At the meeting on 15 January 2015, the HWB agreed to adopt a number of delivery strategies as annexes to the JHWS. It was agreed to bring a paper back to the 30 April HWB meeting to present the full updated version of the JHWS, to include updated statistical information.

3.0 KEY POINTS

- 3.1 The changes made to the JHWS are largely to add more up to date data and statistics, where these are available, correct any wording that is out of date or no longer relevant, and to outline the new approach of adopting key partnership strategies as annexes to the JHWS.
- 3.2 This includes information from some of the Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNAs) completed since the JHWS was first published in 2012.
- 3.3 The JHWS' six priorities and areas of main focus remain the same.
- 3.4 The updated JHWS is attached in full as Appendix A.

3.5 As discussed at the 15 January HWB meeting, work to develop a new JHWS for Cambridgeshire will begin in 2016 to succeed the current strategy, which expires in 2017.

4.0 ALIGNMENT WITH THE CAMBRIDGESHIRE HEALTH AND WELLBEING STRATEGY

4.1 This paper outlines updates to the Cambridgeshire Health and Wellbeing Strategy 2012-17.
