

Part 3F – Delegations Resulting from Covid-19

Relevant officers (a list of all relevant officers is held by the Monitoring Officer) of Peterborough City Council, Cambridge City Council, South Cambridgeshire District Council, Huntingdonshire District Council, East Cambridgeshire District Council and Fenland District Council are hereby authorised by Cambridgeshire County Council to act under and carry out the functions conferred on the Local Authority (Cambridgeshire County Council) by the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984 (the "Act") as amended, and any subordinate legislation made under the Act, in particular, but not limited to the Health Protection (Coronavirus Restrictions) (England) Regulations 2020, as amended.
