6.	Tenison Road – Zebra Crossing Provision	<p>It was resolved</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) to approve implementation of the zebra crossing as identified in feature option 6 and in accordance with the original scheme approval on 25th March 2015.
7.	Traffic Regulation Order objections associated with Lansdowne Road, Cambridge	<p>It was resolved to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) implement the restriction as advertised b) inform the objectors accordingly
