Reasons for taking decision	 The report was presented at the meeting to allow the officer to explain the proposals. It was noted that: The applicant meets the County Council's eligibility criteria (apart from having access to off street parking but which the applicant has difficulty accessing especially when carrying shopping etc). Due to the limited width of the carriageway it is not possible to install a disabled persons parking bay on the same side of the carriageway to the applicant's property without causing an obstruction. Disabled Persons Parking Bays in residential areas can play an important role in helping maintain independence. If a Disabled Persons Parking Bay is no longer required it can be removed and reverted back to general use. There is sufficient provision in the accessibility budget 2020-21.
